Guidelines for Submission of Abstract/Full Paper

- ❑ Abstract (language: English or Hindi) should not exceed 300-500 words including keywords (*Font: Times New Roman 12, justified with 1.15 spacing, 1 inch margin (2.5 cm) on all sides*).
- ❑ Abstract should include the Title of the paper, name of the author(s) and presenter along with affiliation and email ids & contact numbers, and theme of the conference under which the abstract is sent.
- ❑ Abstract will be subjected to a review process and only those abstracts approved by the reviewers will be selected for Oral / Poster Presentation and subsequently communicated.
- ❑ The research paper should be between 3000-5000 words.
- ❑ The research paper must be an original analysis and the author's own work. Previously published research papers will not be accepted. A similarity index of less than 20% is required.
- ❑ Submit the research paper in both word and PDF format.

- ❑ The Conference provides an excellent opportunity for participants to present their original research, engage in knowledge-sharing, and contribute to shaping India's global narrative. 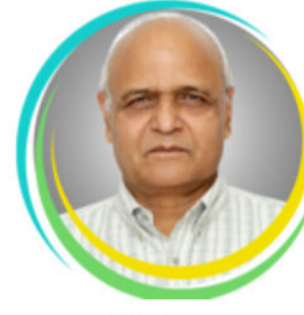
